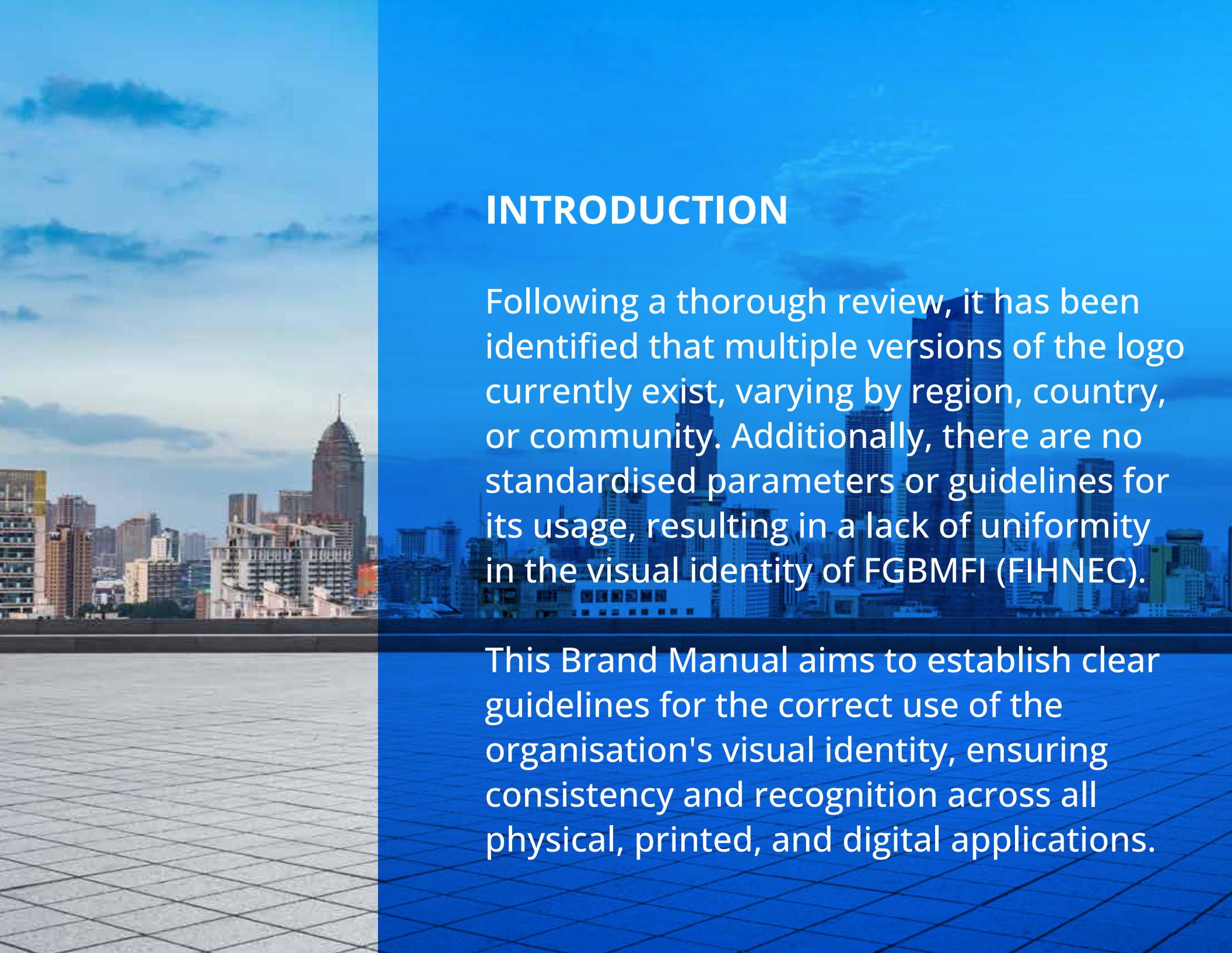

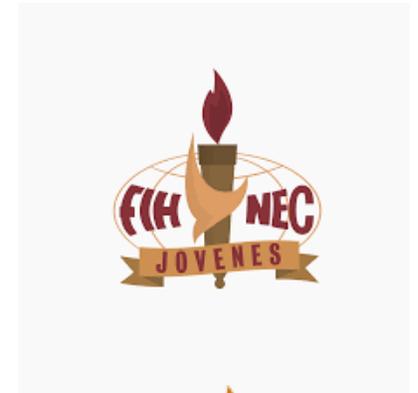

INTRODUCTION

Following a thorough review, it has been identified that multiple versions of the logo currently exist, varying by region, country, or community. Additionally, there are no standardised parameters or guidelines for its usage, resulting in a lack of uniformity in the visual identity of FGBMFI (FIHNEC).

This Brand Manual aims to establish clear guidelines for the correct use of the organisation's visual identity, ensuring consistency and recognition across all physical, printed, and digital applications.





PURPOSE OF THE MANUAL

This document seeks to unify the image of FGBMFI by standardising the logo, colours, typography, and other visual elements. In doing so, it ensures a coherent application across various communication channels and promotional materials.

Addressed to administrative members, communication and marketing teams, and graphic designers, this manual provides guidelines to ensure a faithful and high-quality reproduction of the brand. It does not restrict creativity but serves as a guide for effective communication and a solid projection of the institutional identity.



VISUAL IDENTITY

Logo and Its Meaning

The logo represents the organisation graphically and consists of the typography "**FGBMFI**", the acronym for *Full Gospel Business Men's Fellowship International*. This design aims to convey the international character of the fraternity, guided by the flame of the Holy Spirit. It incorporates symbolic visual elements such as the globe, torch, and white dove.

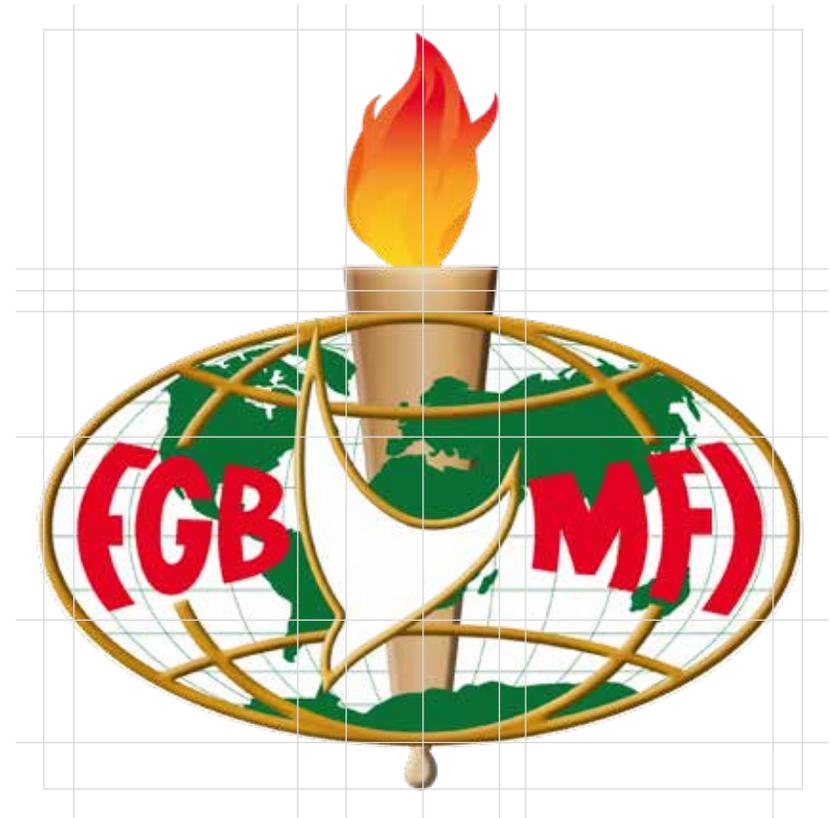

Structure and Composition

The logo is designed within a grid that organises its main elements:

- **Centre:** The torch with the flame and dove, representing the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
- **Background:** The globe, symbolising the organisation's international presence.
- **Sides:** The acronyms positioned on either side of the dove.



Protection Area

To ensure the visibility and legibility of the logo, a protection area is established, free from other graphic or textual elements. The height of this safety zone is defined by the distance between the base of the torch and the edge of the globe.

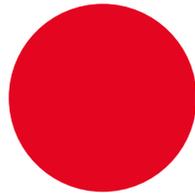

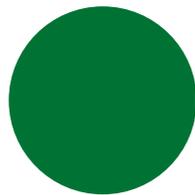

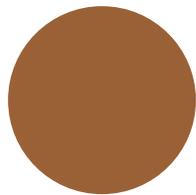


The institutional colours of FGBMFI reflect the organisation's identity and values. The following primary tones are defined: Yellow, red and green.
